Courir De Mardi Gras Parade Rules

In the interest of public safety, any activity that is potentially dangerous is prohibited. This includes:

Any and all antics that may be dangerous to spectators or participants

ELIGIBILITY - Only registered applicants are eligible to participate. Minimum age for participation is 6 years of age and older – no exceptions.

RULES - It is required that participants comply with rules and regulations as stated in the application.

PARTICIPANTS – Are responsible his/her on actions. Placing emphasis on **safety at all times**.

COSTUMING is encouraged; need not be elaborate.

GATE ADMISSION – Ticket required for parade participants that wish to enter the festival grounds after the parade.

THROWS - Should be customary Mardi Gras throws, such as cups, doubloons, beads etc. Sufficient amounts are necessary. Candy is prohibited. To ensure spectator safety, toss the throws a reasonable distance into the spectators.

BEVERAGES - Only plastic and paper containers allowed.

LINEUP - starts at 5:30 P.M. at Neches & Crockett Street in designated area. Applicants who are pre-registered will be lined up first and On-site registrants will follow.

FIREARMS are prohibited.

TRASH - It is your responsibility to pickup **ALL** trash and dispose of properly. Do not leave trash in the line up area, find a dumpster.

FAMILY EVENT – Behavior not consistent with the family affair philosophy of MGSET is prohibited and may result in expulsion. City ordinance as well as MGSET prohibits encouraging spectator nudity, indecent attire and characterization.

Cajun music, fun and colorful costumed participants, horseback riders, wagons, buggies and more. It's a thrill to watch revelers of all ages chase after the friendly animals hoping to gather the ingredients for a gumbo. Enjoying chasing the chickens, catch a greased pig. Parade ends with traditional gumbo or enjoy a variety of Cajun food from festival vendors. Each Courir de Mardi Gras is special in its own way, so get ready, enjoy the chase it's all about tradition and the chicken !

No animals are hurt in the processes of catching the chicken or pig. They are pets and belong to Mardi Gras participants.
